

In groundbreaking achievement, the Georgetown Public Hospital Corporation successfully (GPHC) its performed first laparoscopic donor nephrectomy, marking a significant advancement in kidney transplant surgery in Guyana.

The laparoscopic donor nephrectomy was conducted on a female donor who selflessly contributed her kidney to a 17-year-old male relative.
